Dear Ms. Moncada,

Pursuant to Rule 25-6.0185, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), electric utilities that own or control electric generation facilities are required to file a long-term energy emergency plan and periodic updates with both the Florida Public Service Commission (Commission) and the Florida Reliability Coordinating Council. The utilities are required to review their plans every three calendar years and either submit a revised plan for Commission approval or provide a letter indicating the adequacy of the existing plan.

On February 1, 2021, Florida Power & Light (FPL) filed its revised Emergency Plan for Capacity Shortages/Transmission Limitations and Long Term Fuel Shortages (Plan) in both clean copy format and legislative (type/strike) format (Document No. 01820-2021). Commission staff has reviewed the Plan and considers the overall procedures of the Plan to be consistent with the requirements of Rule 25-6.0185 F.A.C. Therefore, the Plan is hereby administratively approved. Staff requests that FPL notify the Commission of any changes to the Plan as filed.
