FPUC has requested waiver of Rule 25-17.250(1), Florida Administrative Code. The rule provides that each investor-owned utility shall, by April 1 of each year, file with the Commission a standard offer contract or contracts for the purchase of firm capacity and energy from renewable generating facilities and small qualifying facilities with a design capacity of 100 kW or less. Additionally, a separate standard offer contract shall be based on the next avoidable fossil fueled generating unit of technology type identified in the utility's Ten-Year Site Plan.
