PURPOSE AND PROCEDURE:

The purpose of this hearing is to consider the petitions of Gulf Power Company, Utilities, Inc. of Florida, and Florida Public Utilities Company for approval of a regulatory asset to record costs incurred due to COVID-19 and any motions or other matters that may be pending at the time of the hearing. The Commission may rule on any such motions from the bench or may take the matters under advisement.

At the hearing, all parties shall be given the opportunity to present testimony and other evidence on the issues identified by the parties at the prehearing conference held on June 2, 2021. All witnesses shall be subject to cross-examination at the conclusion of their testimony.

Attendance by any party, representative of a party, or witness at the prehearing or hearing may be in person or virtual. The Public Service Commission will use a combination of technologies to ensure full participation. For those who choose to participate or appear virtually, the Commission will employ GoToMeeting as an audio and video platform, which will include a telephone number for audio-only participation. A GoToMeeting invitation shall be provided to counsel for each party. It shall be the responsibility of counsel to provide their clients, client

This proceeding will be governed by Chapter 366 in addition to Chapter 120, Florida Statutes, and Rules 25-22, 28-106, and 28-109, Florida Administrative Code.
