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## **QUESTION:**

Please refer to Florida Power & Light Company's (FPL) response to Staff's First Data Request, No. 13(b), where the utility indicated "FPL's industrial use per customer increased in 2020; however, this is increase [which] is not attributable to impacts from the pandemic." Please explain what caused the increase in FPL's industrial use per customer last year.

## **RESPONSE:**

For year ending 2020, the industrial rate class saw use per customer grow 2.4 percent, and this usage increase due to a 4.2 percent increase in kWh sales compared to a 1.7 percent increase in customer growth. Most of the sales increase was driven by just two rates, CILC-1T and GSLDT-3, and these rates have 16 and 4 customers, respectively. No additional information is available regarding what caused the increase in FPL's industrial use per customer last year.
