On June 8, 2021, Florida Power & Light (FPL) filed a request for confidential classification pursuant to Sections 366.093(3)(c) and (e), Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C). This request pertains to information contained in FPL's response to Vote Solar's First Request for Production of Documents (POD) Nos. 10, 42, and 43.

FPL requests confidentiality, in its entirety, of POD No. 10 under Section 366.093(3)(e) F.S.: "[I]nformation relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of the information." Staff reviewed FPL's confidentiality request pertaining to this response; which contains SAIDI Benchmarking Data, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of FPL. FPL also requests confidentiality, in their entirety, of its responses to Vote Solar's POD Nos. 42 and 43 under Section 366.093(3)(c) F.S.: "[S]ecurity measures, systems, or procedures." Staff has reviewed FPL's confidentiality request pertaining to these responses; which contain very detailed procedures, security measures, and proprietary data provided by a third-party vendor, the disclosure of which would also harm FPL.

After reviewing the documents and information included in FPL's response to Vote Solar's POD Nos. 10, 42, and 43, staff concurs with FPL. In staff's opinion, FPL's request meets the criteria for confidentiality set forth in Section 366.093(3)(c) and (e), F.S. Therefore, staff recommends that FPL's request for confidential classification of the information contained in Document No. 04607-2021 be approved.
