RE: Docket No. 20210113-TP – Notice of adoption of existing interconnection agreement between Windstream Florida, LLC and Venture Corporation d/b/a INdigital, Inc. by Bright House Networks Information Services (Florida), LLC.

On June 18, 2021, Windstream Florida, LLC filed a notice of adoption by Bright House Networks Information Services (Florida), LLC of the existing interconnection agreement between Windstream Florida, LLC and Venture Corporation d/b/a INdigital, Inc., approved in Docket No. 20200233-TP. Bright House Networks Information Services (Florida), LLC is adopting the entire agreement pursuant to Section 252(i) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996.

Under the requirements of 47 U.S.C. § 252(e), negotiated agreements must be submitted to the state commission for approval. Section 252(i) requires that a local exchange carrier make available a previously-approved agreement in its entirety. Any exception to said obligation is governed by 47 U.S.C. § 51.809(b) and may be filed when such exception exists.

The filing met the criteria outlined in Section 2.07.C.5.b. of the Commission's Administrative Procedures Manual. Accordingly, with this Memorandum, the docket is hereby closed.
