FPL hereby notifies the Commission that, on August 3, 2021, FPL submitted to the NRC an SLRA for the Operating Licenses for St. Lucie Units 1 and 2. By its SLRA, FPL seeks to extend the term of each operating license by 20 years beyond its current expiration date. The current renewed Facility Operating License for St. Lucie Unit 1 expires on March 1, 2036, and the current renewed Facility Operating License for St. Lucie Unit 2 expires on April 6, 2043.
