Recommendation: No. Staff recommends that oral argument was not requested consistent with the requirements of Rule 25-22.0022, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), and that the pleadings are sufficient for the disposition of this matter. However, if the Commission chooses to hear oral argument at its discretion, staff recommends providing 5 minutes per party.




