I agree with AARP that FPL's proposed settlement allows for a too generous 10.6% ROE for FPL. Also, the proposed settlement doesn't explain the need for a new solar base rate adjustment mechanism. The proposed settlement includes nearly \$20 million in industry association dues paid by customers with no requirement for FPL to prove how the dues are used to benefit customers. FPL is the only major utility with no absolute carbon emissions reduction goals. Florida has among the highest average residential electric bills and saw among the largest increases in bills (20%) - all while FPL boasted on its TV ads how it saves customers money. FPL should reduce the increases to our residential electric bills even more than what is in the settlement.
