CenturyLink Communications, LLC (FRN: 0018-4219-41) a Lumen company (CenturyLink)¹ hereby applies for authorization pursuant to Section 63.71 of the Federal Communications Commission's (Commission) rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.71, and Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 214, to grandfather its Digital Voice (VoIP) service provided to Quantum Fiber customers in Florida, Missouri and Nevada.² CenturyLink ultimately plans to discontinue these services but is not seeking authority to do so at this time.

As of November 15, 2021, or as soon thereafter as the necessary regulatory approvals can be obtained, CenturyLink will no longer offer Digital Voice service to new customers.

3. Points of Geographic Areas of Service Affected

CenturyLink seeks authority to grandfather the provision of Digital Voice service in Florida, Missouri and Nevada.

4. Description of Service Affected

Digital Voice service is a residential voice service delivered over an IP infrastructure (VoIP) and includes features customers normally associate with landline service such as the ability to make and receive voice calls (local and long distance), Caller ID, emergency 9-1-1 calling, voicemail, 3-way calling, and call blocking.

The public convenience and necessity will not be adversely affected by the grandfathering of the services described herein. No other products or services are impacted by this application.

5. Brief Description of the Dates and Methods of Notice to All Affected Customers

CenturyLink notified customers of the plan to grandfather Digital Voice service via e-mail on October 12, 2021. Those customers were notified that the proposed grandfathering would take effect on November 15, 2021, or as soon after that date as authorized by the relevant regulatory commissions. A copy of the customer notification is appended hereto. (See Attachment A.)

6. Whether the Carrier is Considered Dominant or Non-dominant with Respect to the Service to be Grandfathered

CenturyLink is considered non-dominant with respect to the services to be grandfathered.

7. Other Information
