SECTION 63.71 APPLICATION OF MCI COMMUNICATIONS SERVICES LLC; MCIMETRO ACCESS TRANSMISSION SERVICES OF VIRGINIA, INC.; AND MCIMETRO ACCESS TRANSMISSION SERVICES LLC

MCI Communications Services LLC; MCImetro Access Transmission Services of Virginia, Inc.; and MCImetro Access Transmission Services LLC (collectively, "the MCI Entities") submit this Application for authority under Section 214(a) of the Communications Act and Section 63.71 of the Commission's rules to grandfather and discontinue certain U.S. Private Line services for approximately 43 customers who inadvertently may not have received the customer notification associated with the MCI Entities' April 15, 2021, Section 63.71 application to grandfather and discontinue these same services (the "April 2021 application").

In connection with the April 2021 application, the MCI Entities provided notices to customers of the specified U.S. Private Line services by mail on or before April 15, 2021. The April 2021 application was deemed automatically granted on June 28, 2021.² The MCI Entities learned that approximately 43 customers (the "Missed Customers") of these services may not have received the customer notices.

Therefore, on or before October 29, 2021, the MCI Entities notified/re-notified the Missed Customers of the proposed grandfathering and discontinuance. Copies of the notices are attached to this Application as Exhibit A. The notices explain that subject to the terms and conditions of applicable contracts or of the product guide, the MCI Entities will cease accepting moves, adds, or changes from the Missed Customers for the specified U.S. Private Line services on or after December 31, 2021, as specified below, and will discontinue these services on or after March 31, 2022.

The MCI Entities are not incumbent LECs; they offer these services as interexchange carriers (IXC) or competitive LECs. As noted in the April 2021 application, none of the approximately 43 customers at issue here are residential or consumer customers, and the services are not plain old telephone service ("POTS").

Consistent with Section 63.71(a) and (c) of the Commission's rules, the MCI Entities provide the following information:

2. Date of Planned Service Discontinuance (47 C.F.R. §§ 63.71(a)(2), (c)(2)):

Pursuant to its earlier approved discontinuance application, the MCI Entities ceased offering the specified U.S. Private Line services to new customers in the contiguous United States and the District of Columbia as of June 30, 2021 (the services are "grandfathered" as defined in 47 C.F.R. § 63.60(d)).

Subject to the Commission's authorization, on or after December 31, 2021, the MCI Entities will not permit the Missed Customers to make moves, additions, or changes ("MACs") in most cases. MACs will be allowed if any of the following conditions (the "MACs-allowed conditions") applies:

- A circuit originates or terminates in any of the following areas: Connecticut,
 Delaware, the District of Columbia, Maryland, Massachusetts, New Jersey, New
 York, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, and Virginia (collectively, the "Exception
 Areas").
- Any services that are provisioned with a telecommunications service priority ("TSP") designation as of December 31, 2021.

Subject to the Commission's authorization, on or after March 31, 2022, the MCI Entities will discontinue the specified U.S. Private Line services as to the Missed Customers in the geographic areas identified in Section 3 below.³

3. Points of Geographic Areas of Service Affected (47 C.F.R. §§ 63.71(a)(3), (c)(2)):⁴

Except with respect to the Missed Customers, the MCI Entities have already obtained Commission authorization to grandfather and discontinue the specified U.S. Private Line services in the contiguous United States and the District of Columbia in accordance with the April 2021 application.

The Missed Customers currently have the specified U.S. Private Line services in the following jurisdictions: Arizona, California, Colorado, Florida, Illinois, Michigan, Missouri, Tennessee, Texas, and Washington. Subject to the Commission's authorization and as stipulated by this application, on or after the date specified in Section 2, the MCI Entities will not permit the Missed Customers to make MACs unless a MACs-allowed condition applies.

Subject to the Commission's authorization and as stipulated by this application, on or after the date specified in Section 2, the MCI Entities will discontinue the specified U.S. Private Line services as to the Missed Customers except for circuits that originate or terminate in any of the Exception Areas.

4. Brief Description of Type of Service Affected (47 C.F.R. §§ 63.71(a)(4), (c)(2)):

This Application relates to certain U.S. Private Line services offered by the MCI Entities. These are not "plain old telephone service" or POTS services. The MCI Entities' U.S. Private Line services provide private line transmission service in the contiguous United States and the District of Columbia, originating in a Company-designated point-of-presence (POP) in one Local Access Transport Area (LATA) and terminating in a Company-designated POP in another LATA via interexchange carrier (IXC) transport. U.S. Private Line services offer a suite of analog, digital, and SONET services available on point-to-point, point-to-multipoint, and multipoint configurations. The following specific U.S. Private Line services are covered by this Application:

- Analog point-to-point, point-to-multipoint and multipoint configurations
- Digital DS0 point-to-point, point-to-multipoint and multipoint configurations
- Point-to-point Fractional DS1 (DS1)
- Point-to-point Digital DS1 (Digital Signal Level 1)
- Optional feature: Web Digital Reconfiguration Services (Web DRS); and
- Optional feature: Echo Control

Alternative Services and Products: Customers today can obtain alternative services and products from Verizon or other providers that may suit customers' needs depending on the customers' particular applications. Possible alternative products and services include: Private IP, Ethernet Dedicated E-Line, Ethernet Switched E-Line, and Internet Dedicated Ethernet services. Verizon will work with affected customers to find suitable alternative solutions.

5. Brief Description of the Dates and Methods of Notice to All Affected Customers (47 C.F.R. § 63.71 (c)(3)):

The Missed Customers were sent notices by U.S. mail on or before October 29, 2021.

Representative copies of the notices are attached as Exhibit A.

Separately, on or before October 29, 2021, copies of this Application were sent by U.S. mail to the governor and public utilities commission of each affected state, to federally-recognized tribal nations in each affected state, and to the Department of Defense Chief Information Officer, as required by Section 63.71(a) of the Commission's rules.

6. Regulatory Classification of Carrier (47 C.F.R. § 63.71(c)(4)):

The MCI Entities are classified for regulatory purposes under the Commission's rules as non-dominant with respect to the services to be discontinued.

CONCLUSION

The MCI Entities respectfully request that the Commission approve this Application.
