The Company has implemented the purchases of major infrastructure investments and these assets are being depreciated at approved rate per PSC order PSC-12-0043-PAA-GU issued on December 19, 2016. Assets still in service are expected to have continued useful life as noted in the depreciation study proposed depreciation rates based on management's best estimate of the savage value and the remaining useful life of the assets. Management's assessment of savage value is based on prior experience in deposition of similar assets, while the assessment of useful life is based on the asset's performance actual operating environment.
- 4. Management propose adjustment to the following assets useful life or depreciate rates:

 - b. 379 Measuring and Regulating Eqt.- City Gate
