STATEMENT OF CHANGES

The Commission published its Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in Volume 47, No. 200, of the October 14, 2021, issue of the Florida Administrative Register. By letter dated October 26, 2021, the staff of the Joint Administrative Procedures Committee (JAPC) provided comments on proposed Rule 25-30.4345, F.A.C.

JAPC noted that paragraph (2)(c) of the rule provides that the Commission may require such other notice as it finds reasonably necessary. JAPC asked by what standards or under what general circumstances the Commission exercises this discretion. JAPC further commented that pursuant to section 120.58(8)(d), Florida Statutes, a rule that is vague, fails to establish adequate standards for agency decisions, or vests unbridled discretion in the agency is an invalid exercise of delegated legislative authority. Upon consideration of these comments, the Commission changed proposed Rule 25-30.4345, F.A.C., to delete paragraph (2)(c).
