Docket No. 20080271-EI was opened to monitor the status of joint ownership discussions associated with Florida Power & Light Company's ("FPL's") Turkey Point Units 6 & 7, as directed in Order No. PSC-08-0237-FOF-EI, issued April 11, 2008.

By Order No. PSC-08-0237-FOF-EI, the Commission approved a stipulation which states in relevant part: "No later than July 1, 2009, FPL will continue its good faith discussions with FMEA, FMPA, and OUC, and will also commence good faith discussions of joint participation in Turkey Point Units 6 & 7 with JEA and Seminole. FPL will report the status of such ongoing status discussions to the FPSC every quarter thereafter."

As required by Order No. PSC-08-0237-FOF-EI, FPL has continued good faith discussions with the Florida Municipal Energy Association ("FMEA"), Florida Municipal Power Agency ("FMPA"), Orlando Utilities Commission ("OUC"), JEA, and Seminole Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("Seminole").

FPL provided an update to the joint ownership discussion group on June 29, 2018 advising them of FPL's decision to pause moving on with the pre-construction or construction activities given the current status of the initial wave of AP1000 projects in the U.S. No further activity has occurred since the June 29, 2018 update.
