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1	PROCEEDINGS
2	CHAIRMAN FAY: Mr. Kunkler, you're recognized
3	to present Item 4 when you're ready.
4	MR. KUNKLER: Good morning, Commissioners.
5	Item 4 addresses Duke Energy Florida's petition for
6	approval of a plant account and depreciation rate
7	for company-owned electric vehicle DC fast charge
8	stations. Staff is recommending approval of a new
9	subaccount within FERC account 370. Subaccount
10	370.7 for DEF's DC fast charge stations. Staff is
11	also recommending approval of the requested
12	10-percent annual depreciation rate which reflects
13	a 10-year life for the DC fast charge station.
14	Further, staff is recommending that Commission
15	approve an implementation date effective January 1,
16	2022. Thank you.
17	CHAIRMAN FAY: Great. Thank you, Mr. Kunkler.
18	With that, Commissioners, I'll take any questions.
19	I have a few.
20	So I know that this is a back up a little
21	bit. Is that better? This is a potentially
22	somewhere to place this new category for these EV
23	charging stations. It doesn't seem to make
24	complete sense. Is there is there a reason, I
25	guess, FERC hasn't established a category that

1	would speak specifically to EV chargers yet?
2	MR. KUNKLER: Correct. There is currently no
3	account within the FERC system of accounts for
4	electric vehicle charging stations or equipment,
5	and the company feels that this is the best and
6	staff feels this is the best at this time, the best
7	account to put these assets.
8	CHAIRMAN FAY: Okay. Great. And if they
9	do if FERC does establish one, we could then
10	move it into that category? Is that
11	MR. KUNKLER: Correct. When an account
12	eventually FERC establishes a electric vehicle
13	account, the company agrees that they will move all
14	those assets, transfer them into that
15	newly-established account.
16	CHAIRMAN FAY: Great. Okay. And then just my
17	last question. So the recommendation states after
18	10 years there would be no net salvage value. I
19	know there's a lot of discussion about the initial
20	installation cost and then maybe some of these
21	charges being updated down the road. If a utility
22	decides to do that, we're not by stating this,
23	this current structure and creating this, we're not
24	stating that they couldn't change that in the
25	future if they decided to change what they thought

1	could be invested?
2	MR. KUNKLER: No, sir. The Commission will
3	have other opportunities, further opportunities in
4	the future, to reevaluate when the company files
5	their next depreciation study. So we should have
6	more information in regard to these.
7	CHAIRMAN FAY: Yeah. We just don't know, you
8	know, once these are installed down the road, how
9	quickly they need to be changed or adapted to new
10	vehicles on the market, and I just want to make
11	sure we're not foreclosing them to be able to do
12	that from an accounting perspective.
13	MR. KUNKLER: Yes.
14	CHAIRMAN FAY: Great. With that,
15	Commissioners, I'm comfortable with this item.
16	I'll take a motion, if there aren't any questions
17	or discussion.
18	COMMISSIONER GRAHAM: Move staff
19	recommendation on all issues on Item No. 4.
20	COMMISSIONER LA ROSA: Second.
21	CHAIRMAN FAY: We have a motion and a second
22	on all items all issues for Item 4. All those
