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1	PROCEEDINGS
2	CHAIRMAN FAY: All right. Commissioners, next
3	we will move to Item No. 4. For further
4	discussion, item also includes an oral
5	modification. We'll make sure staff presents that
6	if you have any questions on that change also. So,
7	Ms. Norris, you are now recognized to present the
8	item.
9	MS. NORRIS: Good morning. Amber Norris with
10	the Division of Accounting and Finance. Item No. 4
11	is the consolidated docket addressing Gulf's
12	petitions for recovery of incremental storm
13	restoration costs related to Hurricane Sally and
14	Zeta, along with FPL's petition for evaluation of
15	storm restoration costs associated with Hurricane
16	Isaias and Tropical Storm Eta.
17	Staff is recommending storm restoration costs
18	of 227.3 million for Hurricane Sally and 11.4
19	million for Hurricane Zeta to be recovered through
20	surcharge. Additionally, staff is recommending
21	approval of storm restoration costs of 68.4 million
22	for Hurricane Isaias and 115.9 million for Tropical
23	Storm Eta, which were charged to base O&M expense.
24	An oral modification was filed with each of
25	your offices and placed in the docket file, and I'm

1	happy to walk through that, as well, if you'd like.
2	CHAIRMAN FAY: Okay. Great. If you wouldn't
3	mind, Ms. Norris, just briefly update us on that
4	modification.
5	MS. NORRIS: Yes. And so that was to correct
6	tables in issue in issue two. Their numbers
7	were transposed in the recommendation and
8	conclusion paragraphs. So that was to correct
9	that, as well as in issue nine is to because the
10	interest is still will still be kind of would
11	be completely recovered in the true-up, that's to
12	get that specific number out of there with staff's
13	recommendation to approve recovery of it.
14	CHAIRMAN FAY: Okay. Great. With that, any
15	questions on the modification, Commissioners? I
16	will take questions or comments on this item.
17	Commissioner Clark, you are recognized.
18	COMMISSIONER CLARK: Thank you, Mr. Chairman.
19	Just a couple of comments and observations.
20	Appreciate the staff's work on this. And I am in
21	support of staff's recommendation in this case.
22	I do have a couple of questions and a comment
23	to make. The charges that were approved for Sally,
24	for Zeta and for Hurricane Michael I know
25	Michael is not included specifically here, but were

1	all of those charges assessed on FPL Northwest
2	outside of the settlement agreement that was
3	reached? Any staff member can answer that.
4	CHAIRMAN FAY: Go ahead, Mr. Stellar.
5	MR. STELLAR: Commissioner Clark, which
6	settlement agreement are you referring to?
7	COMMISSIONER CLARK: Into the rate settlement
8	agreement with FPL.
9	MR. STELLAR: I do not believe these were
10	addressed in that settlement agreement.
11	COMMISSIONER CLARK: So they are outside
12	these charges are outside of the settlement
13	agreement?
14	MR. STELLAR: Correct.
15	COMMISSIONER CLARK: Okay. I wanted to make
16	sure of that. I know that the charges we're going
17	to be looking at after the first of the year, I'm
18	assuming that we're going to see the costs for Ian
19	being brought in, and FPL is going to be bringing
20	those in. Specifically I'm addressing the FPL
21	situation right now. Northwest the Northwest
22	division is still recovering costs for Michael,
23	Zeta and Sally. That's an about \$11 a month, I
24	believe, on those costs. And I assume that Ian's
25	costs are going to be brought in are going to be
1	

1	proposed to be spread over the entire system. And
2	what I would like to see is when the company comes
3	in for their request after first of the year, that
4	they bring us an alternative proposal that would at
5	least consider taking the balance of the costs that
6	are associated with these three storms on Northwest
7	and spreading them across the entire rate base,
8	just like Ian is going to be requested to be spread
9	across the entire rate base. And I'd like to ask
10	staff, if they would, to make that request known
11	and to see if they would be interested in bringing
12	back such a proposal to us when they look at it.
13	Thank you, Mr. Chairman.
14	CHAIRMAN FAY: Thank you. And with that, of
15	course, Mr. Stellar, I guess it would depend on the
16	filings, but just at the direction of Mr. Clark's
17	requests, if we could have that information on that
18	item at that time. It would depend on what's filed
19	in the petition, but I think we could at least
20	substantively provide that.
21	MR. STELLAR: Yes, Mr. Chair. There will be,
22	of course, a new docket opened whenever Ian
23	recovery is
24	CHAIRMAN FAY: Right.
25	MR. STELLAR: and that would be the

1 appropriate place to address this bookmark, if I'm 2. understanding Commission. 3 CHAIRMAN FAY: Yes. Yes, correct. 4 Great. Thank you. Commissioners. Okay. 5 Commissioner Graham, you're recognized. COMMISSIONER GRAHAM: Thank you, Mr. Chair. Ι 7 just wanted to take a minute to thank the 8 prehearing officer for doing such a fine job on 9 this one. 10 CHAIRMAN FAY: Always nice to thank the 11 prehearing Officer, Commissioner Graham. 12 With that, Commissioners, any other comments 13 or questions on this item? We have Commissioner 14 Clark's comments on the record. 15 So, with that, we'll take a motion on Item No. 16 4. 17 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Move the item. 18 COMMISSIONER LA ROSA: Second. 19 CHAIRMAN FAY: We have a motion and a second to 20 approve all issues on the consolidated dockets and 21 include the oral modification. All that approve 22 say, aye. 23 (Chorus of ayes.) 24 CHAIRMAN FAY: Showing none opposed, with that, 25 Item No. 4 passes unanimously.
