9	revisions of its underground residential
10	differential tariff, underground commercial
11	differential tariff and overhead to underground
12	conversion tariff.
13	The underground residential differential
14	tariff applies to new residential subdivisions, and
15	represents the additional costs, if any, FPL incurs
16	to provide underground distribution service in
17	place of overhead service.
18	FPL's proposed differential charges remain
19	zero for low density, high density and meter
20	pedestal subdivision models.
21	Additionally, FPL is proposing revisions to
22	its overhead to underground conversion tariff.
23	Specifically, FPL is seeking to include the waived
24	existing facilities cost for all non-hardened
25	overhead distribution facilities and net plant in

1	service.
2	Staff believes that the proposed tariffs are
3	reasonable and recommends approval.
