Extension - Document No. 03316-2020

On December 20, 2023, pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Duke Energy Florida (DEF or Company) requested a second extension of confidential classification for certain highlighted information contained in documents produced by DEF in preparation for the Office of Public Council's (OPC) June 24, 2020 deposition of Jeff Adix. Specifically, DEF seeks confidential treatment for Document No. 03316-2020, Bates Nos. ADIX DEP DT 00001 through ADIX DEP DT 00342.

On July 15, 2020, DEF filed the original Request for Confidential Classification related to this document. DEF's Request was granted by Order No. PSC-2020-0359-CFO-EI on October 9, 2020. Subsequently, on March 29, 2021, DEF filed its First Request for Extension of Confidential Classification for this document. That request was granted by Order No. PSC-2022-0228-CFO-EI on June 27, 2022.

In the current request for extension, the Company is claiming confidentiality for certain information appearing in Document No. 03316-2020 under Section 366.093(3)(d) and (e), F.S. Per the Statute, propriety of confidential business information includes, but is not limited to: Subsection (d) "Information concerning bids or other contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of the public utility or its affiliates to contract for goods or services on favorable terms," and Subsection (e) "Information relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of information." Information provided in Document No. 03316-2020 for which confidential treatment is being sought includes commercially sensitive confidential information concerning contractual obligations reflected in the contract between DEF, ADP CR3, LLC and ADP SF1, LLC. The contract between these parties relates to the accelerated decommissioning activities for the DEF Crystal River Unit 3 Nuclear Plant.

Staff has reviewed the information contained in the documents produced by DEF, as well as the Company's confidentiality request. In staff's opinion, the information that is the subject of the confidentiality request does meet the criteria for confidentiality contained in Section 366.093(3)(d) and (e), F.S. Therefore, staff recommends that the current request for extension of confidentiality of certain information included in Document No. 03316-2020 be approved.
