Request for Confidential Classification for Document No. 06601-2023

On December 14, 2023, Peninsula Pipeline Company, Inc. (Peninsula) filed a request for confidential classification for Document No. 06601-2023. This document contains certain information in Exhibit A to the firm transportation service agreement with FPUC for the Boynton Beach project on page 2 and Exhibit A to Amendment No. 1 to the firm transportation agreement with FPUC for the New Smyrna Beach project on page 17. Specifically, Peninsula identified the monthly reservation charge and unauthorized use rate on page 11, as well as the total Maximum Daily Transportation Quantity, total monthly reservation charge, and the unauthorized use rate on page 17.

Staff reviewed the document and concurs with Peninsula that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Sections 366.093(3)(d) and (e), Florida Statutes (F.S.), whereby disclosure of the information would harm the competitive business operations of Peninsula. Therefore, staff recommends that the request by Peninsula for confidential classification of Document No. 06601-2023 be approved.
