RE: Docket No. 20220061-SU - Application for transfer of wastewater Certificate No. 318-S from BFF Corp to CSWR-Florida utility Operating Company, LLC, in Marion County.

Pursuant to Order No. PSC-2023-0257-PAA-SU (Order), issued August 21, 2023, CSWR-Florida Utility Operating Company, LLC (CSWR or Utility) was required: (1) to notify the Commission within 90 days of the Order that its books have been adjusted in accordance with the Commission's decision; (2) submit the executed and recorded warranty deed and a copy of its application for permit transfer to the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) within 60 days of the Order; (3) submit a copy of the signed and executed contract for sale within 60 days of the Order; (4) to provide proof of mailing the customer notice; and (5) verification that revised tariff sheets have been filed with the Commission. The Order also advised that this docket shall be closed administratively in the event the Order becomes final and the aforementioned actions are completed.

The Order became final pursuant to Order No. PSC-2023-0289-CO-SU, issued on September 18, 2023. On December 12, 2023, CSWR provided a copy of the executed and recorded warranty deed for the land upon which its facilities are located, an explanation that it purchased bulk wastewater treatment capacity and does not have treatment facilities, and therefore no wastewater permit from the DEP to transfer, and a copy of the signed and executed contract for sale. On December 15, 2023, the Utility submitted revised tariff sheets and an affidavit of mailing the customer notice stating that the notice was mailed to customers on December 14, 2023. On December 19, 2023, CSWR notified the Commission in writing that its books have been updated to reflect the Commission-required accounting adjustments. Staff has determined that the Utility has demonstrated compliance with Order No. PSC-2023-0257-PAA-SU, and requests that this docket be closed administratively.
