Per our discussion I'm requesting a correction to the corporate type for the City of Ocala in MCD. The details are below.

The City of Ocala sent an email requesting a name change to its fictions name. While researching their request we realized their fictitious name was not registered with Florida Secretary of State. The City of Ocala's attorney stated they were not required to register their fictitious name due to they are a municipality, and after a review of the statutes by our attorneys, they agreed. However, we looked in MCD and noticed that the City of Ocala's certificate was coded as a corporation. The City of Ocala's application to provide telecommunication service in Florida (document 02285-1997), which was filed in 1997, indicates it's municipality-owned. Therefore, we are requesting the corporate type for the City of Ocala's certificate 4865 be changed to municipality owned. Thank you.
