On March 28, 2024, Peninsula Pipeline Company, Inc. (Peninsula or Company) filed a request for confidential treatment for Document No. 01368-2024. This document contains confidential information from Exhibit A to the firm transportation service agreement with Florida City Gas (FCG). The confidential information contained relates to the total maximum daily transportation quantity, maximum hourly transportation percentage, and the monthly reservation charge.

In its request for confidentiality, Peninsula asserts that disclosure of this information would cause harm to both the Company and FCG, as the information relates to competitive interests. Furthermore, Peninsula states that both the Company and FCG treat the highlighted information provided in Document No. 01368-2024 as confidential.

Staff has reviewed the document and concurs with Peninsula that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 366.093(3)(d) and (e), Florida Statutes, whereby disclosure of the information would impair the competitive business operations of Peninsula. Therefore, staff recommends the request by Peninsula for confidential classification of Document No. 01368-2024 be approved.
