On April 21, 2025, Florida Power & Light Company (FPL or Utility) filed a request for confidential treatment of information provided in response to Staff's First Data Request, No. 9 (Document No. 03352-2025). The confidential information contained in this document can be described as proprietary programs and processes used in FPL's Integrated Resource Planning.

In its request for confidentiality, FPL asserts that disclosure of this information would harm the Utility as the information relates to proprietary confidential business information. Furthermore, FPL states that the Utility treats the information provided in Document No. 03352-2025 as private and has not publicly disclosed it. If disclosed, it may impair the value of these programs and processes, and harm FPL's competitive business interests.

Staff has reviewed the document and concurs with FPL that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 366.093(3)(e), Florida Statutes, whereby disclosure of the information would impair FPL's competitive business interests. Therefore, staff recommends that the request by FPL for confidential classification of Document No. 03352-2025 be approved.
