Peoples Gas System, Inc. (PGS) requests confidential classification of certain highlighted information contained in responses to OPC's 1st request for PODs and 1st set of interrogatories. More specifically this information has to do with employee salaries and personal information, actual and projected revenues, as well as forecasting information provided by third parties.

According to PGS, the disclosure of this information would harm the ability of the company and its affiliates to do business as the document includes information consisting of labor rates, and calculations as well as employee information related to PGS and its affiliates.

Staff has reviewed PGS's confidentiality request and agrees that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 366.093(3)(d), (e), and (f) F.S. Therefore, staff recommends that the request for confidentiality of certain information included in Document No. 03274-2025 be approved.
