On June 4, 2025, Peoples Gas System, Inc. (PGS or Utility) filed a request for confidential treatment of Document No. 04239-2025. This document contains highlighted confidential information provided in response to Staff's Fifth Set of Interrogatories, Nos. 26 and 31. The confidential information contained in this document identifies contract bidders and proposed project costs, PGS's bid selection rationales, and prospective CNG customers.

In its request for confidentiality, PGS asserts that disclosure of this information would harm the Utility as the information relates to bids and other contractual data, and competitive interests. Furthermore, PGS states that the Utility treats the highlighted information provided in Document No. 04239-2025 as private and has not publicly disclosed it. If disclosed, it may impair PGS's ability to contract for goods and services on favorable terms, and harm the Utility's competitive business interests.

Staff has reviewed the document and concurs with PGS that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Sections 366.093(3)(d) and (e), Florida Statutes, whereby disclosure of the information would impair PGS's ability to contract for goods or services, and impair the Utility's competitive business interests. Therefore, staff recommends that the request by PGS for confidential classification of Document No. 04239-2025 be approved.
