On June 9, 2025, Duke Energy Florida (DEF or Company) submitted a request for confidential treatment of Document No. 04436-2025. This document includes confidential transmission system information, specifically transmission planning information regarding potential failure scenarios.

In its request for confidentiality, DEF asserts that the information concerns security measures, systems, or procedures, and also constitutes proprietary confidential business information related to its transmission system. Furthermore, DEF states that the information provided in Document No. 04436-2025 is treated as private and has not been publicly disclosed. The disclosure of this information would present significant security risks to DEF, its customers, and the grid, and would also impair the competitive business of DEF and its affiliates.

Staff has reviewed the document and concurs with DEF that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 366.093(3)(c) and (e), Florida Statutes, whereby disclosure of the information could represent a security risks to the Company and would impair their ability to compete in the marketplace. Therefore, staff recommends the request by DEF for confidential classification of Document No. 04436-2025 be approved.
