On April 29, 2025, Florida Power & Light Company (FPL or Company) filed a request for confidential treatment of Document No. 03243-2025. This document contains confidential information in response to OPC's Eleventh Set of Interrogatories (ROG), No. 316. The confidential information contained can be described as FPL's financial analysis in determining the feasibility of converting FPL's nuclear generation units fueling schedule from 18-months to 24-months, including projected costs and budgets.

In its request for confidentiality, FPL asserts that disclosure of this information would harm FPL, as the information relates to competitive interests. Furthermore, FPL states that the Company treats the highlighted information provided in Document No. 032343-2025 as private and has not publicly disclosed it.

Staff has reviewed the documents and concurs with FPL that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 366.093(3)(e), Florida Statutes, whereby disclosure of the information would impair its competitive business interests. Therefore, staff recommends the request by FPL for confidential classification of Document No. 03243-2025 be approved.
