Docket No. 20250011-EI: FPL is seeking a substantial rate increase, with estimates suggesting increases of at least \$200 annually by 2027 and potentially higher. FPL's previous rate hikes have already placed a burden on customers, with some reports indicating a 60% increase in bills over the last five years for some individuals.
