On July 14, 2025, Duke Energy Florida, LLC (DEF or Company) filed a request for confidential treatment of Document No. 05902-2025. This document contains confidential information provided in DEF and Placid Solar's executed large generator interconnection agreement. The confidential information contained can be described as project specifications, pricing, interconnection requests and project milestones included in the interconnection agreement.

In its request for confidentiality, DEF asserts that disclosure of this information would harm DEF, as the information relates to contractual data and competitive interests. Furthermore, DEF states that the Company treats the highlighted information provided in Document No. 05902-2025 as confidential per the agreement terms and has not publicly disclosed it. If disclosed, it may impair the Company's ability to contract for goods and services on favorable terms and also impair the competitive business of the provider of the information.

Staff has reviewed the document and concurs with the Company that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 366.093(3)(d) and (e), Florida Statutes, whereby disclosure of the information would impair the ability to contract for goods or services on favorable terms of DEF, and impair its competitive business interests. Therefore, staff recommends the request by DEF for confidential classification of Document No. 05902-2025 be approved.
