On July 14, 2025, Peoples Gas System, Inc. (PGS) filed a request for confidential treatment of Document No. 05675-2025. This document contains information associated with various developer agreements, including names, locations, maps, contract timing and pricing, and internal financial review of the projects.

In its request for confidentiality, PGS asserts that disclosure of this information would harm the company, as the information relates to bids or other contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair the ability of the company to contract for goods or services on favorable terms. PGS also asserts that the documents contain information associated with competitive business interests, the disclosure of which would impair its competitive business. Furthermore, PGS asserts that it treats the highlighted information provided in Document No. 05675-2025 as private and has not publicly disclosed it.

Staff has reviewed the document and concurs with PGS that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 366.093(3) (d) and (e), Florida Statutes, whereby disclosure of the information would impair its ability to contract or its competitive business interests. Therefore, staff recommends the request by PGS for confidential classification of Document No. 05675-2025 be approved.
