Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.) and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Florida Power & Light Company (FPL or Company) filed a request for confidential classification of Document No. 05635-2025 on July 11, 2025. This document contains certain highlighted information provided in supplemental response to FL Rising, LULAC, and ECOSWF's Thirteenth Request for Production of Documents, specifically No. 93. The highlighted information within Document No. 05635-2025 can be described as negotiated capacity and energy prices as well as strategic planning documents proprietary to FPL.

In its request for confidentiality, FPL asserts that disclosure of this information would harm the Company, as the information relates to bids or other contractual data and proprietary competitive business information. Furthermore, FPL states that the Company treats the highlighted information provided in Document No. 05635-2025 as private and has not publicly disclosed it. If disclosed, it may impair the Company's ability to contract for goods and services on favorable terms and also impair the competitive business interests of the provider of the information.

Staff has reviewed FPL's confidentiality request and agrees that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 366.093(3)(d) and (e), F.S., whereby disclosure of the information would impair FPL's ability to contract for goods and services on favorable terms and impair the competitive interests of FPL. Therefore, staff recommends that the request for confidentiality of certain information included in Document No. 05635-2025 be approved.
