SECTION 63.71 APPLICATION OF AT&T

AT&T¹ applies for authority under Section 214(a) of the Communications Act, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 214, and Section 63.71 of the Federal Communications Commission's ("Commission") rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.71, to grandfather certain interstate special access ring services provided by its ILEC affiliates in 21 states.

INTRODUCTION

Through this application, AT&T seeks to grandfather Optical Carrier Network (OCN) Point to Point and LightGate service (a.k.a. BellSouth SPA Point to Point Network) Special Access Service (the “Affected Services”) everywhere they are still offered by AT&T’s ILEC affiliates throughout its 21-state footprint (the “Affected Area”). These services provide business customers with dedicated custom networks in a ring architecture and connect multiple customer-designated locations and specified central offices using SONET equipment.

AT&T has previously applied for and received authority to grandfather DS1 and DS3 special access services in certain wire centers within its footprint.² As with AT&T’s earlier applications, grandfathering these outdated services will benefit the public and serve as an important step toward meeting both AT&T’s and the Commission’s goals of advancing toward next-generation technologies that customers are requesting.³

Demand for the Affected Services is low, and businesses in the Affected Service Area have cost-effective alternative options to choose from as replacements for the Affected Services. AT&T offers AT&T Wavelength MetroSM (formerly AT&T Dedicated Ethernet Service), and

AT&T Private Dedicated NetworkSM (formerly Ultravailable Network) as replacements for the Affected Services. In addition, there is an array of competitive offers available in the Affected Service Area, including services offered over cable, fiber, fixed wireless, mobile wireless, and satellite technologies. Due to low demand, the existence of next-generation replacement products, and AT&T's desire to retire its copper network, AT&T no longer wishes to continue providing the Affected Services.

Date of Planned Service Grandfathering:

Effective on or after November 1, 2025, pending regulatory approval, AT&T's Affected Services will be grandfathered.

Points of Geographic Areas of Service Affected:

AT&T plans to grandfather the Affected Services in the Affected Service Area in sections of 21 states: Alabama, Arkansas, California, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Indiana, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Michigan, Mississippi, Missouri, Nevada, North Carolina, Ohio, Oklahoma, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, and Wisconsin.

Brief Description of Type of Service Affected:

AT&T plans to grandfather Optical Carrier Network (OCN) Point to Point and LightGate service (a.k.a. BellSouth SPA Point to Point Network) Special Access Service provided by its ILEC affiliates in the Affected Service Area. These Affected Services provide customers with dedicated custom networks in a ring architecture and connect multiple customer-designated locations and specified central offices using SONET equipment. They are offered only to businesses, so AT&T does not have any residential customers using these services.

Brief Description of the Dates and Method of Notice to All Affected Customers:

AT&T sent customer notices via U.S. Mail on August 15, 2025 to Affected Customers of the Affected Services.⁴ Copies of this Application are being sent via first-class U.S. Mail to the governors, public utility commissions, and federally recognized tribes (if any) in the Affected

Service Area, as well as to the Special Assistant for Telecommunications to the Secretary of Defense, as required by 63.71(a) of the Commission's rules.⁵

Regulatory Classification of Carrier:

AT&T offers the Affected Services pursuant to non-dominant carrier regulation.

Public Convenience and Necessity:

The public convenience and necessity will not be impaired by the grandfathering of these services. The Commission recognized close to a decade ago that TDM-based special access offerings like the Affected Services would soon become “obsolete” in the face of significant advancement in competing services and changes in customer demand.⁶ That prediction has come to fruition, as demand for the Affected Services is very low and it is economically inefficient for AT&T to continue to provide the Affected Services.

Current customers in the Affected Service Area have many options to choose from in lieu of the Affected Services, including AT&T Wavelength MetroSM (formerly AT&T Dedicated Ethernet Service), and AT&T Private Dedicated NetworkSM (formerly Ultravailable Network). The Commission has long recognized the substitutability and superiority of Ethernet services

over TDM-based services.⁷ There also are other broadly available alternatives in the Affected Service Area, which many businesses likely have already transitioned to given the low demand for the Affected Services.

CONCLUSION

Because demand for the Affected Services is low, because there are cost-effective, superior alternatives for prospective customers to choose from, and because transitioning away from copper-based services will advance the FCC's policy goals, grandfathering the Affected Services in the Affected Service Area will not impair the public convenience or necessity.

AT&T respectfully requests the Commission approve its Section 63.71 Application to grandfather services.

Important Notice Regarding Interstate Optical Carrier Network (OCN) Point to Point, and LightGate Special Access Service – Effective on or After November 1, 2025.

Thank you for using AT&T for your business service needs. We want to make you aware of planned changes to your Interstate Optical Carrier Network (OCN) Point to Point, and LightGate service (a.k.a. BellSouth SPA Point to Point Network) Special Access Service (Affected Service). Effective on or after November 1, 2025, pending regulatory approval, customers may not establish new or renew 12-month, and 36-month term plans for the Affected Service, and will no longer be available for purchase by new or existing customers throughout AT&T's 21 state footprint.¹

Optical Carrier Network (OCN) Point to Point, and LightGate service (a.k.a BellSouth SPA Point to Point Network) Special Access Service provides customers with a dedicated custom network in a ring architecture. This self-healing network connects multiple customer-designated locations and specified Telephone Company Central Offices (COs) via Next Generation SONET equipment.

Our records indicate that you currently purchase at least one of the Affected Services listed below. As a current AT&T customer, you may retain your existing service(s) subject to the following changes:

- **Effective on or after November 1, 2025**, AT&T will no longer allow new orders, renewal of service agreements, or requests for physical changes to your service (including moves to different service addresses), unless your contract expressly allows such orders or changes.
- Following the expiration of your current term agreement, AT&T will only allow renewal of the service upon terms specified by AT&T, subject to AT&T's right to change the rates, terms, and conditions of the service upon notification.

AT&T offers AT&T Wavelength MetroSM (formerly AT&T Dedicated Ethernet Service), and AT&T Private Dedicated NetworkSM (formerly Ultravailable Network) as replacements for Optical Carrier Network (OCN) Point to Point, and LightGate (a.k.a BellSouth Point to Point Network) Special Access services.
