FPL IS PROVIDED MONOPOLY STATUS BY THE STATE AND ITS SHAREHOLDERS PROFITS ARE BEING PROTECTED. THIS BUSINESS PLAN IS BY DESIGN NOT ALWAYS IN THE BEST INTERESTS OF THE USERS OF OUR POWER. THAT INCLUDES MUNICIPALITIES, BUSINESS (BIG &SMALL), RESIDENTIAL USERS AND OTHERS.

FPL ACTS AS A FOR PROFIT ORGANIZATION COLLECTING RENTAL FEES FROM OTHERS THAT USER DOLLARS WERE EXPENDED TO ESTABLISH THEIR DELIVERY SYSTEM NEEDS RECOGNITION IN RATE SETTING. ALLOWING FPL TO RENT THE SYSTEM TO (AT&T AND OTHERS) THAT USER DOLLARS PAID TO SET UP AND ACTING AS A BILLING AGENT FOR HOME SERVICES AND OTHERS MUST BE TAKEN INTO ACCOUNT IN ESTABLISHING THE RATE. ALLOWING AS ROUTINE BUSINESS EXPENSES PAYING SALARIES THAT RIVAL WALL STREET, HIRING OF LOBBYING FIRMS, POLITICAL CONTRIBUTIONS AND USE OF MILLIONS IN SCARY MARKETING EMPHASIZING THAT WE HAVE SEVERE UNPREDICTABLE WEATHER AS A RATE ENHANCING TOOL MUST BE RECOGNIZED IN RATE SETTING.

MAYBE POSITIVE ADDS THAT SUGGESTS MITIGATION EFFORTS TO LESSEN THE DAMAGE TO THE DELIVERY SYSTEM WOULD BE BETTER ACCEPTED BY USERS.

THE LAST TIME I LOOKED THE NEW PROPOSED RATES WOULD PROVIDE OVER A 10%+ SHAREHOLDERS PROFIT.
