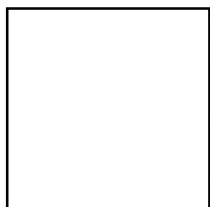

My interest is purely educational and self-directed, and I am happy to receive the information in whatever format is easiest for you to provide.

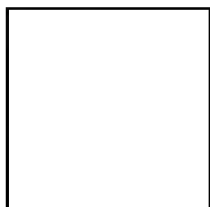
