I am a bit surprised to discover that my "local" electric utility company (Tampa Electric Company) was sold to international business interests based in Canada (Emera Inc., based in Hallifax, Nova Scotia). We (subjects of their monopoly) are now exploited with onerous net metering, solar and TOU restrictions as well as ever increasing rate hikes.
