The Florida Public Service Commission, Office of Commission Clerk (CLK), is requesting clarification of your email address for Docket 20250011. Here's a bit of background so that you understand why we're requesting this information.

- When the *Motion to Intervene* was filed on 6/9/25 (DN 04340-2025) your email address was indicated as: schef@gbwlegal.com

- This past Friday, 9/19/25, a couple of testimonies were rejected for correction and refiling (Efiling ID Nos. 42724 and 42725). The emails related to those rejections were returned to CLK as undeliverable. The email address that was entered when the documents were efiled was: schef@gbkwlegal.com
- On the same day, the testimonies were corrected, refiled, and accepted (Efiling ID Nos. 42731 and 42732), and those emails appear to have been delivered to you at schef@gbkwlegal.com without issue.

CLK did a bit of research to see why the emails were/were not delivered and to compare the information with what we have in the docket. That's how the difference in the email addresses were identified. However, it doesn't explain why two emails were not deliverable on the same day that two others were successfully delivered. It was likely a server issue at that time.

All that being said though, we do need clarification as to which email address should be shown in the parties contact information in Docket 20250011. Thank you for your time and for helping us keep our records as accurate as possible.
