2	CHAIRMAN LA ROSA: Let's jump in for a summary
3	on Item No. 2. Mr. Rubottom, my friend, you are
4	recognized.
5	MR. RUBOTTOM: Thank you, Mr. Chairman, and
6	good morning, Commissioners. Jon Rubottom with
7	Commission legal staff.
8	Item No. 2 is staff's recommendation on two
9	motions by OPC and associating request for oral
10	argument on each motion.
11	First, staff recommends that the Commission
12	deny OPC's motion to dismiss for lack of
13	jurisdiction because the Commission has
14	jurisdiction to consider the subject matter of
15	FCG's petition and because the Commission's
16	decision in this docket will not affect the subject
17	matter of an appeal currently pending before the
18	Florida Supreme Court.
19	Second, staff also recommends that the
20	Commission deny OPC's motion for reconsideration of
21	a Prehearing Order because OPC failed to identify a
22	point of fact or law that the Prehearing Officer
23	overlooked or failed to consider in rendering the
24	order.
25	Additionally, staff recommends denying OPC's

1	request for oral argument because the pleadings are
2	sufficient on their face for the Commission to
3	consider and rule on the motions. However, if the
4	Commission wishes to grant oral argument, staff
5	recommends no more than five minutes per side.
6	Representatives from OPC and FCG are present
7	and would like to address the Commission if oral
8	argument is granted, and staff is available for
9	your questions.
10	CHAIRMAN LA ROSA: Great. Thank you.
11	Commissioners, I, you know, as in reading
12	through the recommendations and reading through the
13	files, I believe that oral arguments wasn't
14	necessary, but I will certainly bring it up to us
15	if we feel any different, Commissioners? Okay.
16	All right. Seeing none, then if there is no
17	further discussion, open for a motion.
18	I am sorry, Commissioner Passidomo Smith, you
19	are recognized.
20	COMMISSIONER PASSIDOMO SMITH: Thank you, Mr.
21	Chair.

2	came in, and I really just want to appreciate
3	thank staff on the recommendation here. I think
4	it's really thorough and it addresses all these
5	motions that were presented. I saw a distinguished
6	the 2025 at that study that is at issue here, I
7	believe it is supported by, you know, fully
8	supported by an independent record, has a different
9	expert witness, new depreciation study, and so I
10	agree with staff that, like, the Commission has not
11	lost jurisdiction and has the subject matter
12	jurisdiction in the Supreme Court's jurisdiction in
13	this case, in my view, and agreeing with staff, it
14	really covers the particular case that's on appeal,
15	which involves FCG's 2022 depreciation study.
16	So with that, I would move approval of staff's
17	recommendation on all issues in this item.
18	CHAIRMAN LA ROSA: Excellent, so hearing a
