2 CHAIRMAN LA ROSA: Let's move to Item No. 6.

3 Mr. Mason, you are recognized, my friend.

4 MR. MASON: Good morning, Commissioners. I am
5 Ian Mason with the Division of Accounting &
6 Finance.

7 Item No. 6 is staff's recommendation to
8 address the final amount of total storm charges
9 collected by Tampa Electric Company for the storm
10 seasons from 2018 to 2022, and the appropriate
11 handling of any over- or under-recovery.

12 This is a follow-up item from the order filed
13 June 13th, 2024, where the Commission approved
14 TECO's petition for recovery of costs and left the
15 docket open until supplemental testimony could be
16 filed detailing the total storm charges collected
17 during the recovery period, as well as the true-up
18 process.

19 On March 19th, 2025, TECO witness Richard J.
20 Latta filed direct supplemental testimony which
21 stated the amount by which TECO over-recovered, and
22 proposed to handle the refund through the
23 Environmental Cost Recovery Clause.

24 Staff has reviewed the filed testimony of
25 Witness Latta, and agrees that the collection of

1 the storm restoration surcharge has led to an
2 over-recovery that should be returned through the
3 Environmental Cost Recovery Clause.

4 Staff is available to answer any questions.
5 Thank you.

6 CHAIRMAN LA ROSA: Thank you.

7 Commissioners, any questions or discussions?
8 Seeing none, open for a motion.

9 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Move approval, Mr.
10 Chairman.
