Staff has reviewed Middleton Utility Company, LLC's August 27, 2025 application to amend its service territory. Based on our review, we find the application to be deficient. The specific deficiencies identified are:

- 1. Notice of Application: Rule 25-30.030(4), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), states that all applications requiring noticing shall be deemed deficient until affidavits of noticing required by Sections 367.045(1)(e) and (2)(t), Florida Statutes, along with a copy of the notice, are filed with the Office of Commission Clerk. Please see attachment A with Staff's suggested edits to the draft customer notice, submitted on August 28, 2025. After the notice has been approved by staff and the notices have been distributed in accordance with Rule 25-30.030(5), F.A.C., please provide affidavits of noticing.
- 2. Land Use Designation: Rule 25-30.036(2)(d)(3), F.A.C., states the applicant shall provide the current land use designation of the proposed service territory as described in the local comprehensive plan at the time the application is filed. Please provide the current land use designation of the proposed service territory.

Your application will not be deemed filed until the deficiencies identified in this letter have been corrected. These corrections should be submitted no later than Monday, October 27, 2025, to the following address:
