On September 3, 2025, CSWR-Florida Operating Company, LLC (CSWR) filed a request for confidential treatment of Document No. 08974-2025. This document contains engineering reports provided in CSWR's application for the transfer of Orchid Springs Development Company's water and wastewater certificates to CSWR.

In its request for confidentiality, CSWR contends that the document contains trade secrets including information concerning bids or other contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair CSWR's ability to contract for goods and services. The information sought includes third party that includes engineering reports and drawings of the facilities. CSWR also contends the document contains information related to their competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair their competitive business. Furthermore, CSWR asserts that the information provided in Document No. 08974-2025 has not been publicly disclosed.

Staff has reviewed the document and concurs with CSWR that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 366.093(3) (a), and (e), Florida Statutes, whereby disclosure of the information would impair its competitive business interests and ability to contract for goods and services on favorable terms. Therefore, staff recommends the request by CSWR for confidential classification of Document No. 08974-2025 be approved.
