FINAL ORDER NO. 18-06 CITRUS COUNTY WATER AND WASTEWATER AUTHORITY

A FINAL ORDER OF THE CITRUS COUNTY WATER AND WASTEWATER AUTHORITY, PURSUANT TO CITRUS COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES, SECTION 102-253(a)(6) [FINAL ORDER TO FIX RATES], PROVIDING FOR THE FIXING OF RATES THAT ARE JUST, REASONABLE, AND COMPENSATORY IN RE: FULL RATE CASE FOR CINNAMON RIDGE UTILITIES INCLUDING TARIFF MODIFICATIONS; PROVIDING FOR CUSTOMER NOTICE; AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Citrus County Code of Ordinances, Section 102-253, established the Citrus County Water and Wastewater Authority (AUTHORITY) and provides for specific powers and duties; and

WHEREAS, Citrus County Code of Ordinances, Section 102-253(a)(6) provides this AUTHORITY with final authority powers to set rates that are "just, reasonable, compensatory, and not unfairly discriminatory"; and

WHEREAS, the AUTHORITY has determined that the application for a full rate case submitted by Cinnamon Ridge Utilities, Inc. (UTILITY) satisfies all applicable requirements of Citrus County Code except for the filing fee requirement which the AUTHORITY hereby waives pursuant to Citrus County Resolution No. 99-142, Section 3.2(1); and

WHEREAS, the AUTHORITY adopted Staff recommendation to use the year 2017 as test year with 2018 pro forma to project the year-end financial performance of UTILITY; and

WHEREAS, the AUTHORITY adopted Staff recommendation to set the projected rate base for the water system at \$247,096; and

WHEREAS, the AUTHORITY adopted Staff recommendation for the total revenue requirement of the water system to be \$134,921; and

WHEREAS, the AUTHORITY adopted Staff recommendation for the rate of return on the water system to be 8.80%; and

WHEREAS, the AUTHORITY adopted Staff recommendation for a rate revenue increase of 16.20% for the water system; and

WHEREAS, the AUTHORITY adopted Staff recommendation to set the new monthly rates for water at \$25.46 for the base facility charge, with the gallonage charge to remain the same; and

WHEREAS, the AUTHORITY adopted Staff recommendation that the Utility Regulation Office review the rates and earning posture of the UTILITY after the 2018 annual report is filed and bring its findings back to the AUTHORITY for a rate adjustment, if warranted, in accordance with Florida Statute 367.081(4)(d); and

WHEREAS, the AUTHORITY adopted Staff recommendation that the new rates, fees, and charges go into effect for services rendered on or after November 20, 2018 to allow the UTILITY sufficient time to issue customer notice as required under County Code; and

WHEREAS, the UTILITY cannot charge any rates, fees or charges not otherwise approved by this AUTHORITY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the AUTHORITY in public meeting assembled, that:

- 1. The above resultant rate adjustments attached hereto as Attachment A, are approved for services rendered on or after November 20, 2018. The new rates shall remain in effect until the AUTHORITY authorizes a change.
- 2. The Utility Regulation Office shall review the rates and earning posture of the UTILITY after the 2018 annual report is filed and bring its findings back to the AUTHORITY for a rate adjustment, if warranted.
- 3. UTILITY shall provide notice to its customers of the revised rates prior to consumption of the respective service at the revised rate.

This Order adopted this 5th day of November, 2018, after motion, second, and majority vote favoring same.

MISCELLANEOUS SERVICE CHARGES — The Company may charge the following miscellaneous service charges in accordance with the terms also stated below. If both water and sewer service are provided, only a single charge is appropriate unless circumstances beyond the control of the Company requires multiple actions.

<u>INITIAL CONNECTION</u> — This charge would be levied for service initiation at a location where service did not exist previously.

<u>NORMAL RECONNECTION</u> – This charge would be for transfer of service to a new customer account at the same location or reconnection of service subsequent to a customer requested disconnection.

<u>VIOLATION RECONNECTION</u> – This charge would be levied subsequent to disconnection of service for cause including delinquency in bill payment.

<u>PREMISES VISIT CHARGE IN LIEU OF DISCONNECTION</u> – This charge would be levied when a service representative visits a premises for the purpose of discontinuing service for nonpayment of a due and collectible bill and does not discontinue service because the customer pays the service representative or otherwise makes satisfactory arrangements to pay the bill.

<u>RETURNED PAYMENT FEE</u> — This charge would be levied when the Company receives notice from the bank that customer's payment was returned and payment was not credited to Company.

<u>LATE PAYMENT CHARGE</u> — This charge will be levied when a customer's billing account is not paid within 16 days, for a Florida Resident, and 21 Days, for a non-Florida Resident, and is therefore delinquent.

TAMPERING FEE – This charge may be levied prior to reconnection of an existing customer for cause in the event that the customer has tampered with the water connection for the purpose of eliminating or reducing the amount they would normally owed the utility, including but not limited to, Jumper Removal, Tampering or Unauthorized Use.

FINAL ORDER NO. 23-07 CITRUS COUNTY WATER AND WASTEWATER AUTHORITY

A FINAL ORDER OF THE CITRUS COUNTY WATER AND WASTEWATER AUTHORITY, PURSUANT TO CITRUS COUNTY CODE 102-256(i), PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF THE 2023 PRICE INDEX FACTOR EQUIVALENT TO THE PRICE INDEX SET ANNUALLY BY THE FLORIDA PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION FOR UTILIZATION IN PRICE INDEX RATE APPLICATIONS FOR NON-EXEMPT, INVESTOR-OWNED WATER AND WASTEWATER UTILITIES PROVIDING SERVICE IN CITRUS COUNTY, SETTING THE EARLIEST APPLICATION DATE FOR UTILITIES TO FILE FOR SUCH AN INDEX ADJUSTMENT, PROVIDING FOR THE FILING OF ADDITIONAL REQUIRED INFORMATION, AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Citrus County Code of Ordinance, Section 102-253, establish the Citrus County Water and Wastewater Authority (AUTHORITY) and provides for specific powers and duties including that of issuing final orders in the matter of rates; and

WHEREAS, Citrus County Code of Ordinance, Section 102-256 (i) and (j) provides for price index and pass through adjustments; and

WHEREAS, the supplemental rules, Resolution No. 99-142, Section 5.2 provides for the procedure for satisfying the filing requirements of a pass-through adjustments and Section 5.3 provides for the procedure for satisfying the filing requirements of a price index adjustments; and

WHEREAS, on May 8, 2023, this AUTHORITY adopted Final Order No. 23-01 establishing the 2023 Price Index of 7.07% for franchised water and wastewater utilities operating in the unincorporated areas of Citrus County; and

WHEREAS, on August 17, 2023, Cinnamon Ridge Utilities, Inc. (Utility) notified the Office of Utility Regulation of its intent to submit application for 2023 price index and pass through adjustments for Cinnamon Ridge Utilities, Inc. Water; and

WHEREAS, on August 17, 2023, Utility met the minimum filing requirements; and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends approval of the Utility's applications which raises the Total Annual Revenues of \$9,243.00 an increase of 10% for Water;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the AUTHORITY, in public meeting assembled, that:

- 1. The above resultant rate adjustments attached hereto as Cinnamon Ridge Utilities, Inc., Price Index and Pass-Through Application Packet are approved for services rendered on or after September 19, 2023.
- 2. Utility shall notify each of its customers of the increase in each customer's next rate billing that is issued more than **fifteen (15)** days after the AUTHORITY'S approval. Within thirty (30) days after implementation of the adjusted rates, the Utility shall file with the AUTHORITY copies of the notices to customers.
- 3. This Final Order shall become effective immediately upon adoption by the AUTHORITY and shall remain in effect until the AUTHORITY authorizes a change.

This Order adopted this 19th day of September 2023, after motion, second, and majority vote favoring same.

NOTICE TO CUSTOMERS

On May 8, 2023, the Citrus County Water and Wastewater Authority adopted provisions under its Final Order No. PSC-2023-01, permitting water and sewer utilities to adjust the rates it charges to customers without those customers bearing the additional expense of a public hearing. These adjustments in rates would depend on increases or decreases in non-controllable expenses subject to inflationary pressures such as chemicals and other general operation and maintenance costs.

On August 16, 2023, Cinnamon Ridge Utilities, Inc. filled notice of intent with the Citrus County Water and Wastewater Authority to increase water and/or wastewater rates pursuant to the provisions in Final Order No. 23-01. If acknowledged and approved by the Citrus County Water and Wastewater Authority, water rates will increase by approximately 10.0%. The adjusted rates should be reflected for service rendered on or after October 4, 2023.
