2	CHAIRMAN LA ROSA: Let's move to Item No. 6.
3	Mr. Nguyen? Oh, there you are. You are
4	recognized, my friend.
5	MR. NGUYEN: Good morning, Chairman and
6	Commissioners. This is Chris Nguyen with the
7	Division of Economics.
8	Item 6 is a joint petition from Peninsula
9	Pipeline Company and Florida City Gas requesting
10	approval of three amendments to transportation
11	service agreements for renewable natural gas
12	projects located in Brevard, Indian River and
13	Miami-Dade Counties. Previously, FCG intended to
14	be responsible for the construction and ownership
15	of the interconnection facilities that connect to
16	each renewable natural gas source.
17	Pursuant to the proposed amendments, Peninsula
18	would construct, operate and maintain
19	interconnection facilities for renewable natural
20	gas facilities to connect to FCG's distribution
21	system.
22	The parties state Peninsula should construct
23	these interconnection facilities because it would
24	not be efficient to have two different entities
25	doing the planning, engineering, permitting work

1	and operation and maintenance on facilities
2	constructed for the same project.
3	As described in the proposed amendments, FCG
4	would pay monthly reservation charges to Peninsula
5	equal to the amount currently paid by their
6	renewable natural gas producers.
7	Based on staff's review of the parties'
8	responses and joint petition, staff recommends that
9	the Commission approve the amendments attached to
10	the recommendation.
11	Thank you.
12	CHAIRMAN LA ROSA: Excellent. Great. Thank
13	you for the summary.
