<u>Issue 1:</u> Should the Commission approve TECO's proposed rates and associated tariffs to implement its 2026 subsequent year adjustment?

Recommendation: Yes. The Commission should approve TECO's proposed rates and associated tariffs to implement its 2026 SYA, because the project timelines, rates, and associated tariffs are consistent with the Commission's prior decision in the Rate Case Order. The rates have been calculated to recover a total 2026 SYA revenue requirement of \$87,727,795 as previously approved by the Commission and as presented in Exhibit 1 of TECO's petition. Consistent with the Rate Case Order, the associated tariffs, included as Attachment A of staff's memorandum dated October 23, 2025, should become effective with the first billing cycle of January 2026.
