Request for Confidential Classification for Document No. 14840-2025.

On October 29, 2025, Peninsula Pipeline Company (Peninsula) and Florida Public Utilities Company (FPUC) filed a joint request for confidential treatment of Document No. 14840-2025. This document contains certain confidential information within the Second Revised Exhibit A to the Second Amendment to the Transportation Service Agreement between Peninsula and FPUC identifying the total Maximum Daily Transportation Quantity, Monthly Reservation Charge, and Unauthorized Use Rate. Peninsula and FPUC explained in their request for confidential classification that both Peninsula and FPUC treat the information as proprietary confidential business information that is not otherwise available in the public domain.

Staff reviewed the document and concurs with Peninsula and FPUC that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 366.093(3)(d), Florida Statutes, whereby disclosure of the information would harm the competitive business operations of Peninsula and FPUC. Therefore, staff recommends that the request by Peninsula and FPUC for confidential classification of Document No. 14840-2025 be approved.
