SECTION 63.71 APPLICATION OF AT&T

AT&T¹ applies for authority under Section 214(a) of the Communications Act, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 214, and Section 63.71 of the Federal Communications Commission's ("Commission") rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.71, to discontinue special access DS1 and DS3 services provided by its ILEC affiliates in certain wire centers located in 19 states.

INTRODUCTION

Through this application, AT&T seeks to discontinue special access DS1 and DS3 services (the “Affected Services”) in portions of certain wire centers located in 19 states (the “Affected Service Area”). AT&T previously grandfathered the Affected Services in the Affected Service Area² and earlier this year discontinued the Affected Services in other AT&T wire centers.³ As with AT&T’s earlier applications, discontinuing these outdated services will benefit the public and serve as an important step toward meeting both AT&T’s and the Commission’s goals of advancing toward next-generation technologies that customers are requesting.⁴

Upon discontinuance, current customers of the Affected Services (“Affected Customers”) will have many cost-effective alternative options to choose from as replacements for the Affected Service Area. These options include AT&T Switched Ethernet as well as other AT&T products that are superior to the Affected Services. In addition, there is an array of competitive offers available in the Affected Service Area, which many businesses have already selected in

lieu of the Affected Services. These alternatives include services offered over cable, fiber, fixed wireless, mobile wireless, and satellite technologies.

Date of Planned Service Discontinuance:

Effective on or after November 15, 2026, pending regulatory approval, AT&T's Affected Services will be discontinued.

Points of Geographic Areas of Service Affected:

AT&T plans to discontinue the Affected Services in the Affected Service Area in sections of 19 states: Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Indiana, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Michigan, Missouri, Mississippi, North Carolina, Ohio, Oklahoma, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, and Wisconsin. Exhibit 1 identifies the list of AT&T wire centers in each state that include any service areas that fall within the Affected Service Area.

Brief Description of Type of Service Affected:

AT&T plans to discontinue special access DS1 and DS3 services provided by its ILEC affiliates in the Affected Service Area.⁵ The Affected Services do not have any residential customers.

Special Access DS1 Service provides a point-to-point channel for the transmission of isochronous serial digital data at rates of 1.544 Mbps.

Special Access DS3 Service provides a point-to-point channel for the transmission of isochronous serial digital data at rates of 44.736 Mbps.

The Affected Services only include *special access* DS1 and DS3 services, and do not include DS1 and DS3 services used for TDM interconnection for the delivery of voice services, including circuits used for Local Interconnection, SS7, or E911 selective router terminations.⁶

Brief Description of the Dates and Method of Notice to All Affected Customers:

Customer notices were sent via U.S. Mail on November 14, 2025 for Affected Customers of the Affected Services.⁷ Copies of this Application are being sent via first-class U.S. Mail to the governor, public utility commission, federally recognized tribes (if any) in the Affected Service Area, and to the Special Assistant for Telecommunications to the Secretary of Defense, as required by 63.71(a) of the Commission's rules.⁸

Regulatory Classification of Carrier:

AT&T offers the Affected Services pursuant to both dominant and non-dominant carrier regulation, depending on the location.⁹ For administrative ease, AT&T submits this application and issued customer notices as if it is subject to the dominant carrier provisions of Sections 63.71(a)(5)(ii) and (f)(1) of the Commission's rules.

Public Convenience and Necessity:

The public convenience and necessity will not be impaired by the discontinuance of these services. The Commission recognized close to a decade ago that DS1 and DS3 technologies would soon become “obsolete” in the face of significant advancement in competing services and changes in customer demand.¹⁰ That prediction has come to fruition, as demand for DS1 and DS3 services is very low. As a result, it is economically inefficient for AT&T to continue to provide the Affected Services.

Affected Customers have many options to choose from in lieu of the Affected Services. Most importantly, in the Affected Service Area, existing and prospective DS1 and DS3 customers, including wholesale customers, can secure cost-effective alternatives through AT&T Switched Ethernet, AT&T Dedicated Internet, and AT&T Wavelength Metro Service (formerly called AT&T Dedicated Ethernet Service). AT&T Business Fiber is also available in portions of the Affected Service Area. The Commission has long recognized the substitutability and superiority of Ethernet services over DS1 and DS3 services.¹¹

There are other broadly available alternatives in the Affected Service Area, which many businesses have already selected in lieu of the Affected Services, including services from cable or fiber providers, such as Charter or Xfinity, among others.¹² Other customers in the Affected

Service area may be instead purchasing services through fixed wireless providers, such as T-Mobile and/or Verizon. Still others may have switched to other wireless options in lieu of wired services, such as AT&T Wireless Broadband; mobile wireless service (voice and broadband) from providers including T-Mobile, Verizon, and/or AT&T; or service from satellite providers such as Viasat, HughesNet, or Starlink.¹³ Notably, the Commission has previously approved multiple AT&T applications to grandfather and discontinue the Affected Services in areas within AT&T's footprint with the same services cited as alternatives.¹⁴

Because there are numerous cost-effective, superior alternatives for prospective customers in the Affected Service Area to choose from, and because most customers have already left for such alternatives, discontinuing the Affected Services in this area will not impair the public convenience or necessity.

**Important Notice Regarding Interstate DS1 and DS3 Service – Effective on or After November 15, 2026**

Thank you for using AT&T for your business service needs. We want to make you aware of planned changes to your interstate special access DS1 and DS3 Service (the “Affected Services”), in certain AT&T wire centers. Effective on or after November 15, 2026, pending regulatory approval, AT&T will no longer offer special access DS1 and DS3 Service at the locations listed at the bottom of this letter.¹ For clarity, DS1 and DS3 service used for Local Interconnection, Tandem Switched Access, SS7, or E911 selective router terminations is unaffected by this action and will remain available for purchase.

DS1 Service provides a point-to-point channel for the transmission of isochronous serial digital data at rates of 1.544 Mbps. DS3 Service provides a point-to-point channel for the transmission of isochronous serial digital data at rates of 44.736 Mbps.²

Our records indicate that you currently purchase Affected Services in at least one of the wire centers impacted by these changes.³ Your affected service addresses are listed below. As a current AT&T customer, you may retain your existing service(s) subject to the following changes:

- **Effective on or after November 15, 2026**, pending regulatory approval, AT&T will no longer offer special access DS1 Service or DS3 Service, after which it is subject to disconnection.

You may continue to use the Affected Services until November 15, 2026. AT&T offers AT&T Switched Ethernet on Demand, AT&T Dedicated Internet (ADI), and AT&T VPN (AVPN) as replacements for DS1 and DS3 Services.

We are here to help if you have any questions about special access DS1 Service or DS3 Service. We are ready to provide support when and how you need it.
