GENERAL SUBJECT MATTER TO BE CONSIDERED: Docket No. 20250084-SU – Application for staff-assisted rate case in Orange County, by Gulfstream Utility LLC. The purpose of the meeting is to give customers and other interested persons an opportunity to provide comments and ask questions regarding the quality of service the utility provides, the proposed rate increase, and other relevant issues.
