**NOTICE OF INTENT TO FILE PETITION  
FOR TRANSMISSION LINES NEED DETERMINATION**

Pursuant to Section 403.537, Florida Statutes, Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL"), hereby gives notice of its intent to file a Petition for Transmission Lines Need Determination for its Andytown-Oasis Transmission Lines project in Broward and Miami-Dade Counties.

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3. The Andytown-Oasis Transmission Lines project will include four new transmission lines: one 500kV line starting at FPL's existing Andytown substation in Broward County ending at FPL's planned Oasis substation in Miami-Dade County; one 500kV line starting at FPL's existing Quarry substation in Miami-Dade County ending at FPL's planned Oasis substation in Miami-Dade County; one 230kV line starting at FPL's planned Oasis substation in Miami-Dade County ending at FPL's existing Quarry substation in Miami-Dade County; and one 230kV line starting at FPL's planned Oasis substation in Miami-Dade County ending at FPL's existing Levee substation in Miami-Dade County.

4. The counties, regional planning councils, and water management districts in whose jurisdiction the Andytown-Oasis Transmission Lines project could be placed are: Miami-Dade and Broward Counties; South Florida Regional Planning Council; and the South Florida Water Management District.

5. FPL reasonably expects to file the Petition for Determination of Need for the Andytown-Oasis Transmission Lines project on March 11, 2026. Pursuant to Section 403.537(1)(a), Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.075, Florida Administrative Code ("F.A.C."), the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") is required to hold a hearing on FPL's Petition within 45 days after the filing of the Petition. Based on FPL's proposed filing date, the hearing is required to be held by April 24, 2026.<sup>1</sup>

6. Pursuant to Section 403.537(1)(a), Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.075(2) and (3), F.A.C., upon receipt of this Notice of Intent, the Commission is required to schedule a hearing,

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<sup>1</sup> Rule 25-22.075(1)(b), Florida Administrative Code, allows FPL five (5) additional days beyond the targeted date of March 11, 2026 for the filing of its Petition without potentially extending the 45-day hearing deadline. Thus, based on the targeted Petition filing date of March 11, 2026, and allowing for a potential additional five (5) days, the deadline for FPL to file the Petition is March 16, 2026.

publish notice of the hearing at least 45 days before the hearing date in the Florida Administrative Register, and provide notice of the hearing to the following:

- (a) FPL;
- (b) Florida Department of Commerce, Division of Community Development;
- (c) Florida Department of Environmental Protection;
- (d) Each person who has requested placement on the mailing list for receipt of such notice;
- (e) Miami-Dade County;
- (f) Broward County;
- (g) South Florida Regional Planning Council;
- (h) South Florida Water Management District; and
- (i) Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission.

7. In addition, under Section 403.537(1)(a), Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.075(4), F.A.C., the electric utility (FPL) shall publish notice of the hearing, at least 45 days before the hearing, by publication of a notice, at least one-quarter page in size, in newspapers of general circulation in the counties (Broward and Miami-Dade) in which the lines are planned to be located.

8. FPL has filed this Notice of Intent to enable the Commission to set a hearing date for the docket and to allow this notice process to commence in a manner that will comply with the requirements of Section 403.537, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.075, F.A.C.

WHEREFORE, FPL respectfully requests that the Commission:

- (a) Set a date no later than April 24, 2026, for the final hearing in this docket;
- and,

- (b) Provide notice of such hearing date at least 45 days in advance by the methods and to the person(s) and entities specified in the applicable statute and rule.
