Re: Docket No. 20260000-OT - Florida Power & Light Company's Fuel Emergency Plan

Dear Ms. Moncada:

Pursuant to Rule 25-6.0185, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), electric utilities that own or control generation facilities are required to file a long-term energy emergency plan with the Commission and the Florida Reliability Coordinating Council. Such plans establish a systematic means to assess and respond to a prolonged fuel supply shortage. In addition, each utility must provide a periodic notification to the Commission that it has reviewed its energy emergency plan. Such written notification is required every three years, beginning with January 31, 1999, and should include either a revised plan for approval or a statement that the current plan on file with the Commission is adequate.

On January 30, 2026, Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) filed a notification that its Fuel Emergency Plan, dated January 31, 2024, is still adequate and complies with the requirements of Rule 26-6.0185, F.A.C. Thank you for this notification and FPL should file its next notification of review by January 31, 2029. In order to streamline the review process, I would ask that any subsequent plan revisions be provided in both type-and-strike and clean formats.
