On February 11, 2026, Florida Power & Light (FPL) filed a request for confidential classification pursuant to Section 366.093(3)(e) of the Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C), for information contained in FPL's response to Staff's First Data Request (Nos. 19 and 20).

FPL claims the documents contain information that is protected by Section 366.093(3)(e), F.S. FPL asserts the documents contain proprietary business information provided by a third-party vendor to FPL. Specifically, the information contains economic reports and forecasts that are proprietary to the third-party vendor which are available only by subscription. The public release of this information could impair the competitive business interests of FPL and the third-party vendor. The information is intended to be and has been treated by FPL as private and its confidentiality has been maintained.

Staff reviewed the documents and information included in the data request response and concurs with FPL. In staff's opinion, FPL's request meets the criteria for confidentiality set forth in Section 366.093(3)(e), F.S. Therefore, staff recommends that FPL's request for confidential classification of the information contained in Document No. 01055-2026 be approved.
