Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, The Federal Executives Agency ("FEA") requests confidential classification of certain information sent in response to staff's first request for production of documents ("POD") and Florida Power & Light's ("FPL") first POD. More specifically, the information for which confidentiality is sought relates to both parties' POD No. 3. This filing contains the work papers used to develop FEA's testimonies and exhibits, and satisfies both parties' request.

According to FEA, the confidential information contains information relating to FEA's competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of the information. Specifically, the documents contain proprietary information compiled by third parties that FEA pays a fee to access, such as credit ratings and financial forecasts.

Staff has reviewed FEA's confidentiality request and agrees that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 366.093(3)(e), F.S. Therefore, staff recommends that the request for confidentiality of certain information included in Document No. 07698-2025 be approved.
